

BRICKS FOR THE BARRACKS

Pictured on the cover is the last remaining World War II barracks at Fort Knox and one of the last original barracks still left standing from the WWII era.

In May 2011 this barracks was moved seven miles to a new location in front of our museum. Our mission is to restore it to its original 1940's condition down to the bunk beds and footlockers. When renovated, it will be the first exhibit that visitors explore. It will also be an exciting addition to the exhibits planned for our new museum at Fort Knox, THE GENERAL GEORGE PATTON MUSEUM.

The WWII barracks recently relocated to our front door must be renovated before it can be viewed by the public.
