

Mechanized Force Photo Collection 1.5 linear feet

This is a collection of negatives and prints of the U.S. Army's Mechanized Force, a unit that existed only during 1931. The Mechanized Force was organized in early 1931 from elements supplied by various branches of the U.S. Army and was disbanded by late summer of 1931. The remnants were transferred to Fort Knox, where they formed the basis for the 7th Cavalry Brigade Mechanized. Most of the negatives are marked "MF-31-X" with "X" being the linear number for the negative. MF = Mechanized Force, 31 = 1931. There are approximately 350 negatives and prints. Those titles in quotes are the exact title given by the photographer. All others are simply descriptive titles given to help identify the shot. **RESTRICTED ACCESS**
